

Freedom of Information Request – film funding applications

Thank you for your Freedom of Information Request, dated 28th February 2011

Your request was as follows:

I'm contacting you on behalf of the Kent Film Office with an enquiry regarding film funding applications, especially since learning of the SEEDA's imminent closure in April 2012.

Unfortunately I haven't been able to find the information I was searching for on your website which relates to the timespan filmmakers might expect to still procure some funding from you, in the area of film production in the South East. Can you give me any information on this matter?

I have checked with the relevant team here at SEEDA and can confirm that there are no funding streams available through SEEDA for the film making industry.
