

RE: Freedom of Information request – International House Artwork

Introduction

Thank you for your original request dated 25th March 2011 and made under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act 2000. Your original request is as follows:

How much was paid for the artwork to International House, who authorised it and how was it justified?

On the 28th March 2011 SEEDA contacted you to inform you that we will require some further information in order to process your Freedom of Information Act request within the 18 hour limit, as described in Section 12 of the Act. In that correspondence we asked you to confirm if your request related to the recently installed lighting installation, details of which were included within the media article linked to our previous email, or other artwork, such as the pieces created by local artist Oliver Winconek in March 2010.

I note that we are yet to receive the clarification we requested from you. Please note that we are unable to proceed with this responding to this request without clarification being received from you. Therefore I feel that I must notify you that unless we receive a response within 20 working days of the date of this letter we will consider that you are satisfied with the information previously provided and that you no longer wish to proceed with this matter as a formal Freedom of Information Act request.
